Trustee Skillset

The primary role of **Ngati Pukenga ki Pakikaikutu Charitable Trust** is to benefit Ngati Pukenga ki Pakikaikutu whānau through promoting positive inter-relationships, growing knowledge of te reo Māori, tikanga, whakapapa and history, supporting those in need and facilitating the preservation and sustainable development of Pakikaikutu whenua including moana.

People with the following desirable skills are being sought:

- A good communicator who will keep people informed and respond to kāinga issues
- Strong people and negotiation skills
- Community oriented
- Lateral thinking and problem solving skills
- Planning and strategic thinking to maintain a future focus
- Sustainable development and environmental knowledge
- Social development experience
- Cultural development experience
- Business development knowledge
- Ensure **Ngati Pukenga ki Pakikaikutu Charitable Trust** infrastructure is in place and robust
- Financial literacy to monitor the financial performance and assets of **Ngati Pukenga ki Pakikaikutu Charitable Trust**

Candidate Eligibility

A candidate must **not** be:

- an undischarged bankrupt or has made any composition or arrangement with his or her creditors
- under the age of 18 years
- convicted of a crime involving dishonesty (section 2(1) of the Crimes Act 1961) or s373(4) of the Companies Act 1993 and sentenced within the last 7 years (unless eligible under the Criminal Records (Clean Slate) Act 2004)
- convicted of an indictable offence (unless an eligible person under the Criminal Records (Clean Slate) Act.
- prohibited from being a director or promoter of, or being concerned or taking part in the management of, an incorporated or unincorporated body under ss382, 383 or 385 of the Companies Act 1993.
- subject to a compulsory treatment order under the Mental Health (Compulsory Treatment and Assessment) Act 1992 or is subject to a care and protection order under the Protection of Personal and Property Rights Act 1988.
- A person who is subject to a property order made under ss 30 or 31 of the Protection of Personal and Property Rights Act.

Candidate Profile Statement and Photo

Candidate Profile Statements will be available to registered members prior to voting.

The Profile:

- Must not exceed 250 words in total (excluding the candidate's name).
- Must be confined to information concerning the candidate, and the candidate's intentions if elected to the Trust.
- May include information about the candidate's pepeha, tribal affiliation, occupation, current qualifications, personal interests and community involvement.
- If provided electronically must be a word.doc
- May include a recent (i.e. less than one year old) photograph of the candidate only. Photos should be in an electronic format (scanned as a jpg attachment on email), but hard copy photos will be accepted and scanned at 300 dpi. Photos will be printed in black and white only but can be supplied in colour. (N.B. hard copies of photos will not be returned to candidates)

The word limit will be strictly enforced.
